Luke 2:33

- And *Joseph* and his mother marvelled at those things which were spoken of him.
- And his father and mother marvelled at those things which were spoken of him.

John 1:18

- No man hath seen God at any time; **the only begotten Son**, which is in the bosom of the Father, he hath declared him.
- "No one has ever seen God; the <u>only God</u>, who is at the Father's side, he has made him known." [ESV]

John 5:39

- Search the scriptures; for in them ye think ye have eternal life: and they are they which testify of me.
- <u>You</u> search the scriptures; for in them you think you have eternal life: <u>but</u> they are they which testify of me.

Acts 2:30

- Therefore being a prophet, and knowing that God had sworn with an oath to him, that of the fruit of his loins, according to the flesh, he would raise up *Christ* to sit on his throne;
- ... he would raise up <u>a descendant</u> to sit on his throne;

Romans 10:17

- Whose adorning let it not be that outward adorning of plaiting the hair,
- Whose adorning let it not be **merely*** that outward adorning of plaiting the hair, [NKJV, NASB] *(both translations place the added word in italics)

2 Peter 3:10

- But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be **burned up**.

Revelation 22:19

- And if any man shall take away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part out of the **book** of life, and out of the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book.
- ... God shall take away his part out of the tree of life, ...
